




Located in Glasgow's fashionable West End on a stunning Victorian Terrace, One Devonshire Gardens offers 49 timelessly styled bedrooms and suites.










ARDBEG








MACALLAN


For a more informal setting, choose the Macallan, with its large comfy chairs and a private bar, it is perfect as a breakout area during the day or for a cocktail event in the evening.

Our beautiful Secret Garden is located in the centre of the hotel and is great for informal interviews or lunch meetings.

















